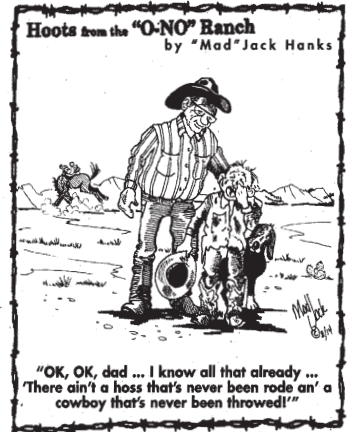


Monthly Ride Report

February 22nd Ride — Rancho Jamul

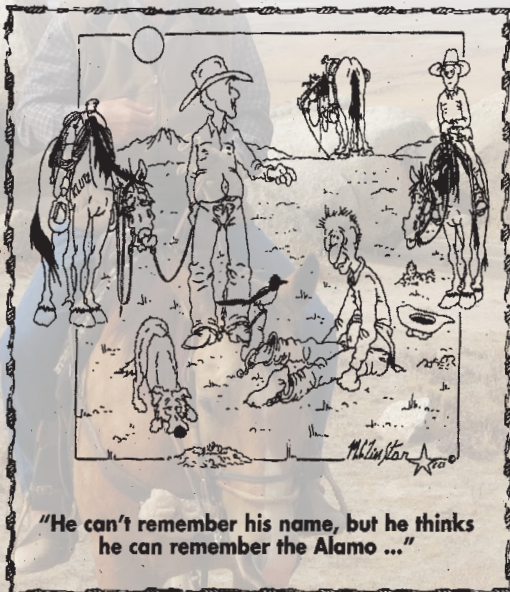
The ride this month will be at Bobbie Daley's ranch. Thanks to Bob Moreau for getting us on the ranch. 🍷
