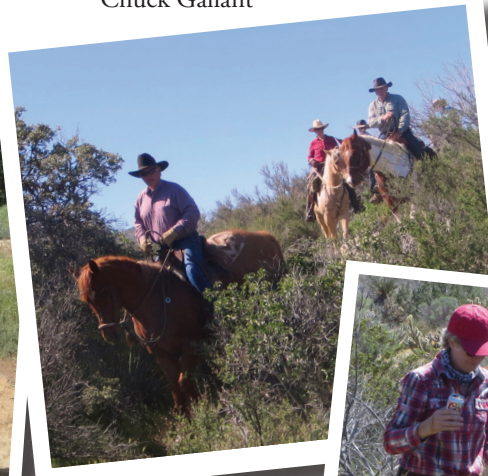
From the Oval Office - President's Report

Our next LS ride together will be at the always beautiful Pamu Ranch in Ramona hosted by Bobby and Janet Neal. This ranch site has old San Diego family history to it as the Fosters bought it in 1902. way to road end at Pamu Road. Turn Left on Pamu Road and down hill past the Ramona landfill sign and soon thereafter the road will turn to dirt and gravel. Continue on till you see the LS sign which will be beyond the cattle guard.
