March Ride - Our next big event and ride campout will be March 21 and 22 at the Stagecoach Trails. Which is located in the high desert, Shelter Valley, 16 miles southeast of Julian and 44 miles north of Highway 8 at Ocotillo. There are showers and clean restroom that are almost new. There is also a pool, laundry, Wi-Fi, a general store and horse corrals. We will be setting up at the horse camping area in which you can bring your own portable corrals, trailer tie or rent pipe corrals from the campground. The cost break down for the overnight camping and individual horse is as follows:

\$26 per night for camping/RV space. Electrical, water, and sewer are included in this price. \$9 per night per horse. Includes stall gate available and water. Bring own buckets/water hose and feed. \$14 per horse that arrive on Sunday day of club ride. The members who are renting cabins will have to stop by the office and pay for their individual arrangements.
