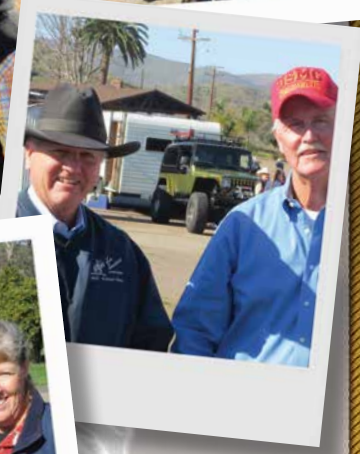
### President's Report

**Directions:** I-8 east to "Exit 40, Japatul Rd, Cuyamaca Park"; turn north, under freeway to Riverside Dr. (after Descanso Junction restaurant) and turn left/north to Perkins Store and Post Office (1 mile); a left (50 feet) and right on Oak Grove (Post Office will be on right); 2 miles then right on Boulder Creek Rd; then 1/2 mile to Burrell Way and turn right then 1/2 mile through the gate to 10523Burrell Way. follow the signs.
