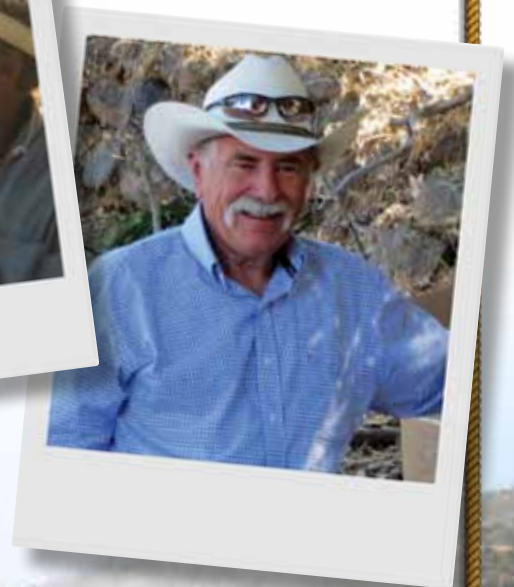
Announcements
