## From the Oval Office - President's Report

We have a revised ride for March....Vista Irrigation Water District has decided not to grant us or the leasing ranchers permission to ride at Lake Henshaw. So that said our Monthly Ride Committee headed up by Ted Van Arsdale have put together a great back up plan. We pre-ride the new ride last Thursday and all the pieces have come together....

Sunday, March 26th. Come Ride at The Banner Queen Resort, Julian.

Just like life on the range, sometimes you gotta make a change of plans. This months LS Ride will be hosted by Kenny Mushet from the Banner Queen Resort of yesteryear. Once a tremendously popular "Dude Ranch" for the affluent through the 40s,50s,60s she now lays quietly at the bottom of Banner Grade Hwy 78. The gate to "Oyos" as they call the 400acres is on the south side of the Highway across from the Old Resort Ranch house. Head in the gate on the dirt road for about 1/2 a mile. If you come for lunch, the gate will be closed to keep cows in. Please leave it as you find it. Our catering will be handled by John and Cathi Little and as usual on our rides, a meal you certainly will enjoy. We should be lucky enough to see some desert blooms. The ride will be gentle terrain so no worries if your horse hasn't had much time out due to the rains.

Directions;

From Descanso- Take Hwy 79 through Cuyamaca into Julian. Turn RIGHT on Hwy 78 down the Banner Grade. The Ranch Gate comes up quickly on the right side as the road begins to level out at the bottom of the Grade. Watch for our Los Senderos sign. Head up the dirt road about 1/2 mile to our staging area.

From Ramona- Take Hwy 67 into town and continue on Main Street (Hwy78) east to Santa Ysabel. Here you will have 2 choices.

1-Continue straight on Hwy 78 into Julian. Turn RIGHT at the 4 way Stop on Hwy 78 and then down the Banner Grade. The Ranch Gate comes up quickly on the right side as the road begins to level out at the bottom of the Grade. Watch for our Los Senderos sign.

2-Turn left on Hwy 79 to S-2. Take the S-2 down to Scissor Crossing and then right on Hwy 78. This route is longer and with less turns. Watch for the Los Senderos sign for the Ranch gate on the left. Head up the dirt road about 1/2 mile to our staging area.
