Directions: Take State Route 79 from Santa Ysabel into Warner Springs and pass the Glider Port. Approximately 1.5 miles from the glider port you will come up to a right hand turn. There is a big wooden sign indicating Puerta La. Cruz work camp. Make the right turn. There will be a dirt road off to the right and entrance to Chaney ranch. This dirt road is approximately 1/8 to ½ mile after the turn off of State Route 79. Follow the dirt road for approximately one mile till you reach the Chaney Ranch Gates.


Pull through and camp/parking on the right. Look for the evening camp circle with BBQ and fire pit.
