Rancho Samataguma 26936 Old Hwy 80, Guatay 91931 From the North- Take Hwy 79 south towards Descanso and turn Left on Old Hwy 80 to Guatay. The Samataguma Ranch sign will be on the left side of the road approx. 1 1/2miles. Follow the entrance road just beyond the house (signs posted) and loop around the water tower into the arena to park.

From the West-Take I-8 east towards Descanso and exit on Hwy 79 towards Rancho Cuyamaca State Park. As you pass Tim Dirkes' Ranchita honk 3 times and continue straight ahead on Old Hwy 80 for approx 1 1/2 miles to the Rancho Samataguma sign on the left. Follow the entrance road just beyond the house (signs posted) and loop around the water tower into the arena to park.
